


A further explanation of how the security on the
NA Members version of the Website
now works

On 12-03-08 the security on the NA Members version of the Website was relaxed. The message:

If you are an NA Member click
here to  [Switch to the NA
Members Version of the Website](#)

..... appears after the banner in the upper left hand corner of the home page. When any Website user chooses to do this, the following pop-up login screen appears:



Did you notice this on the pop-up screen?

We have basically taken security off most of the additional information on the NA Members Version of the site.

giving them the generic NA Members user name: namember and the password: lhad2su, an acronym for the phrase “I have a desire to stop using”, which you will recognize as the only requirement for NA Membership. The reason we prompt for a user name and password is that there **IS** still some information that must be restricted. The revised security approach provides a “secured data area” associated with each service committee/subcommittee including the ASC and ASO. All restricted information is “Tagged”, with a comment in red, indicating that a particular service committee/subcommittee user name and password are required for access. The presumption is that these service committee/subcommittee user names and passwords will be given out in their administrative meetings. In addition each committee/subcommittee has been given an individual ASC Level Trusted Servant user name and password which can access **ANY** committee/subcommittee secured data area. By definition, ASC Level Trusted Servants include ALL additional Voting Members of the ASC except GSR’s. Note: That the only information that is likely to be restricted in this manner will be information which must be kept internal to the standing committees/subcommittees of the ASC.

Following is an example of the type of information that is too sensitive for general release.

The 12 days of NA posting on the activities page contains restricted information in the form of the full street addresses of the NA Members holding open houses for the event.
